

We will be able to use adverbs of frequency correctly in simple present sentences.








Simple Present

Structures



$$S + V + C$$

I wash the car.



She reads a book.
He washes the car.

Read we we you They read a book.

Simple Present

Structures

Negative

S + Do/Does + not + V + C

She "Does"
It Auxiliary

She does not read a book

She reads a book.

"Does"

Auxiliary

They do not read a book

They read a book.

I we you They

Simple Present

Structures

Interrogative

Do/Does + S + V + C + ?

She reads a book. She does not read a book.

Does she read a book?

They read a book. They do not read a book.

Do They read a book?



Let's see what you've learn.

Mary like/likes pizza.

Affirmative

S + V + C

Negative

S + Do/Does + not + V + C

Interrogative

Do/Does + S + V + C + ?

Mary likes pizza.

Mary does not like pizza.

Does Mary like pizza?

Let's see what you've learn.

They learn / learns English.

Affirmative

S + V + C

Negative

S + Do/Does + not + V + C

Interrogative

Do/Does + S + V + C + ?

They learn English.

They don't learn English.


Do they learn English?

Simple present and adverb of frequency

Structure 1: Statements S + Af + V +C.

Mary always brings pizza for lunch.

They Never bring at pizza for lunch.



Simple present and adverb of frequency

Structure 2: Interrogative

How often + do/does + S + V +C +?

Mary always brings pizza for lunch.

How often does Mary bring pizza for lunch?

"always"






Let's complete this examples

Laura 90% (go) to the park in the afternoon.

Laura usually goes to the park in the afternoon.

How often does Laura go to the park in the afternoon?

Adverbs of Frequency

100% Always

90% Usually I always go shooping after work.

70% Often

50% Sometimes

30% Occasionally

10% Seldom

70% Never

Complete the sentences using the simple present and adverbs of frequency.

I get up early. (0%)

I never get up early.

I have breakfast with my family. (100%)

I always have breakfast with my family.

My father reads newspaper on Sundays. (80%)

My Father frequently reads the newspaper on Sundays.
